PPHA is no longer accepting Housing Applications from people who receive Centrelink as their main source of income due to the introduction of the **Victorian Housing Register (VHR)**.

What is the Victorian Housing Register (VHR)?



The VHR is a project by the Victorian Department of Health & Human Services and community housing organisations. It's purpose is to simplify how people on low incomes apply for, and are allocated, public and community housing.

The VHR will combine all community and public housing lists into a central list -

- If you already have a **public housing application** – this may have been merged onto the list – please contact the DHHS Call Centre below for confirmation.
- If you already have a **community housing application with PPHA** – this may be merged onto the list in the second half of 2017.
