PETS POLICY & GUIDELINES

All tenants must seek approval from the Port Philip Housing Association before keeping any pet.

Tenants living in PPHA managed properties (Flat/Unit) may be given approval to keep small pets such as a small dog, or two cats or two birds.

Livestock (such as chickens, goats, cows, horses, etc.) are not permitted, unless allowed under Council By-laws.

Pets can only be kept, on the understanding that they do not:

- Disturb neighbouring households,
- Create a nuisance, or
- Cause a danger to other tenants.

If the pet meets the guidelines the tenant are to be advised that they are fully responsible for the pet and must:

- Care for the pet.
- Ensure the pet does not cause a nuisance to others or soil the common areas (if applicable).
- Not disturb neighbouring households.
- Not endanger the safety of other tenants or staff attending property.

Information regarding pet care and council by-laws are to be provided if available. (This information is also available through the City of Port Phillip Council.)

If serious complaints are received regarding the behaviour of pets further action can be taken.
